



Terms and Conditions for Home Educators events

- Each child must be supervised by an adult who remains with them during the activity at all times. One adult may supervise more than one child in the same workshop.
- All bookings must be made in advance of the day of the activity and paid for at the time of booking, so please have your debit or credit card ready when booking.
- We cannot reserve places without payment.
- All payments are non-refundable and non-transferable except in the event of cancellation by us.
- Events may be cancelled if we do not meet the minimum number of required bookings. If this happens we will contact you to arrange a refund 7 days prior to the event.
- Your tickets will be ready to collect from the Welcome Desk on arrival. Please arrive in good time to do this prior to the start of your booked activity.
- Please be at our Home Educator meeting point next to the 'Bubbles' exhibit on the first floor 10 minutes prior to the activity start time.
- Once the activity has started no late arrivals will be possible.
- Only children booked into the activity may be in the room, along with their accompanying adult.
- Children will be grouped within broad age categories as specified in the programme.
- All our Workshops and Theme Days are group activities that will often require children to follow instructions carefully and work as part of a group that may include children they have not met before. We cannot guarantee sufficient resources for children to work individually.
- No eating or drinking is permitted in the learning rooms except for water in a sealed bottle. Drinking is not permitted when using equipment such as laptops.
- No eating or drinking is permitted in the laboratories at any time.
- All children under the age of 12 are required to be supervised at all times within the main We The Curious venue.
- In the event of needing to contact a child urgently during an activity the Welcome Desk in the main entrance will be able to help.
- All participants are expected to treat others with respect and courtesy at all times and it will be the responsibility of the accompanying adult to ensure appropriate behaviour of children during booked activities.
- In the event of behaviour that is considered to be unsafe, disruptive or that impacts negatively on the learning of others, the presenter or other member of staff may ask an accompanying adult to remove a child from an activity and leave the Education Suite.
